

THE NEXT STEPS

Congratulations Warhawk! We are excited that you are ready to join the Warhawk Family. Here are the next steps to reserve your spot at UW-Whitewater. Please read carefully.

At time of admission you are assigned a **NET ID** and password (7 digit ID number). Your UW-Whitewater email address is the method of communication used by the university. All notifications, confirmations, bills and emergency updates will be sent via this email address. Your email is your **NET ID** @uww.edu. If you have not logged into UW-Whitewater systems (i.e. WINS), please **log in** with your default information (provided in your acceptance letter) to change your password and create a set of challenge questions. Once you have completed this process, be sure to click "Logout" at the top of the screen. 1. REGISTER FOR PLAN-IT PURPLE AND PAY ENROLLMENT DEPOSIT

Plan-It Purple, registration and advising program, is **REQUIRED** for all transfer students. You must participate in the entire program in order to register for your classes. Registration for spring 2017 incoming transfer students begins October 1, 2016. Please pay attention to the registration deadlines.

There are three Plan-It Purple programs available:

Friday, November 18, 2016: (Sophomore, Junior and Senior statuses only)
Registration deadline November 13 at 11:59PM

Friday, December 2, 2016: Registration deadline November 27 at 11:59PM

Thursday, January 12, 2017: Registration deadline January 5 at 11:59 PM

Once you have committed to attending UW-Whitewater, please log into your [WINS](#) account to complete registration. Once you are logged into WINS, select, “Student Center” “UWW Applications” “Plan-It Purple” and “Reserve a Date.” At this time, new students will pay a **non-refundable** New Student Fee (\$50 +15 per guest) and a one-time \$100 Enrollment Deposit. 2. COMPLETE THE UW SYSTEM PLACEMENT TEST(S)

Students may be required to take a math or English placement test if they did not transfer in a direct course for math or English. If you have taken the ACT, your English sub score may be used. Information was included in your acceptance packet if you need to take the UW System placement tests. It is strongly recommended that students take the UW system placement tests prior to attending Plan-It Purple, as students will be unable to register for math or English course if the exams have not been taken. 3. COMPLETE THE FAFSA

If you are applying for financial aid, complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <http://www.FAFSA.gov>. Financial aid does not automatically transfer from one institution to another. If you have already completed the FAFSA for a previous institution, log into your FAFSA and add UW-Whitewater school code (003926). We encourage you to complete the FAFSA as soon as possible. 4. HOUSING INFORMATION

Students that graduated less than two years ago from high school are required to live on campus unless commuting from a parent home, are a veteran, are married or have a dependent living with them. Additional documentation for these exemptions to the residency requirement can be submitted on-line on the housing [website](#) under Student Portal.

On campus housing is available to all incoming transfer students. If interested or required to live on campus, please submit a housing contract on the housing [website](#). The deadline to submit a housing contract and deposit is January 15th. Applications received after that deadline will not be guaranteed on campus housing. 5. SUBMIT FINAL TRANSCRIPT

Students that are enrolled for the fall semester are required to submit a final transcript once grades are posted. Please request to have an official transcript sent to the Admissions Office.
