1. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

UW System application is required for admission to the university, along with high school and all college transcripts, application fee (if appropriate).

2. NON-COURSE REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRANCE INTO THEATRE MAJOR

There is no grade point average minimum requirement for admission to the Theatre major.

3. COURSE REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRANCE INTO THEATRE MAJOR

None. However, students at the UW Colleges are strongly encouraged to complete the following courses during the first and second years.

COM 232 Introduction to Acting
COM 234 Introduction to Stagecraft

NOTE: COM 130 (Introduction to Theatre) and COM 131 (Theatre Laboratory) do not count toward either the major or minor in Theatre.) UW College students who have earned the Associate of Arts and Science Degree will have met all university general studies core, breadth and proficiency requirements. Therefore, students should include the courses listed above as part of the Associate Degree requirements.

4. COURSES REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION NOT IN UW COLLEGES' CURRICULUM
None.

5. SPECIAL NOTES

*UW College students are strongly encouraged to complete the Associate of Arts and Science (AAS) Degree prior to transfer. The AAS satisfies all Whitewater general education requirements except as listed below.

PLEASE NOTE: Some programs require additional general education courses that are not satisfied by the associate degrees as listed above. Following is a listing of these additional requirements:

- A) Bachelor of Arts Degree candidates
 - a. Must complete one course of at least two credits in Arts outside the major, plus six credits in Humanities courses.
- B) Bachelor of Fine Arts and Bachelor of Music candidates:
 - a. Must complete one course of at least two credits in Arts outside the major.
- C) Bachelor of Science Degree candidates:
 - a. Must complete at least six credits in Natural Science/Mathematics in addition to the laboratory science/additional science-mathematics requirement.
