Major Planning Guides are sample programs that illustrate the type of curriculum a student will take to complete the degree in 4 years.

All students must complete a minimum of 120 credits including

- 1) at least 32 units of general education, including specific Gened courses, as well as approved math and science, physical education and elective courses
- 2) requirements for the BA or BS Degree
- 3) requirements for the major and for the minor
- \*You need to begin your Math and English sequences with the appropriate course. Your ACT/SAT scores determine which course is appropriate for you. Refer to your AR for this information and then adjust this schedule accordingly.
- \*\*The Bachelor of Science requires two lab sciences and 5 credits of advanced math or 3 of math and 3 of computer science.
- ^The prerequisite for Psych 215 is completion of Math 141 with a final grade of C or higher.

Courses in **Bold** typeface indicate specific courses that must be completed for the major. Other courses such as Gened Courses or major/minor electives can be selected from a number of course choices.
