The Major Planning Guide is a sample program which illustrates the type of curriculum a <u>new freshman</u> will take to complete the degree in 4 years; it is not an official document. All students must complete a minimum of 120 credits including:

- 1) At least 32 units of general education, including specific Gen Ed core courses, as well as approved math and science, physical education, and elective courses. Your general education electives must come from the following categories: GA, GS, GH, GE, or GI.
- 2) All requirements for the major and minor (if required)
- * Test scores determine placement in Math and English courses. Refer to the AAR for this information and then adjust this schedule accordingly. The Planning Guide begins with the most common placement for this major. Refer to your AR for this information and then adjust this schedule accordingly.

Note: because this is business related major, BS degree requirements do not apply.
