Major Planning Guides are sample programs which illustrate the type of curriculum a student will take to complete the degree in 4 years.

All students must complete a minimum of 120 credits including

- 1) at least 32 units of general education, including specific Gened courses, as well as approved math and science, physical education and elective courses
- 2) requirements for the BA or BS Degree,
- 3) requirements for the major and for the minor if required

An approved minor is required for this major.

* ACT/SAT scores determine which Math and English course is appropriate for you. Refer to your AR for this information and then adjust this schedule accordingly. The Planning Guide begins with the most common placement for this major.

**The Bachelor of Science requires two lab sciences and 5 credits of advanced math or 3 of math and 3 of computer science. This sample plan uses math 230 and computer science 162 as examples.

*** *It is assumed that you will have sufficient foreign language background from high school to begin in the third-semester university course (French 251). If the UW System French Placement Test indicates a higher level, you will start your French studies in a more advanced course and need fewer classes to complete the French major. If, however, the UW System French Placement Test indicates a lower level, you will be starting in a lower course and need additional classes to complete the French major.*
