II. Justification for action

This change is simply designed to highlight the fact that students (particularly transfer students who come in with credit for Biology 141 and 142, but not Math 141) will need to have successfully completed Math 141 before taking genetics. Currently, one of the prereqs for genetics is Chem 102, which itself has Math 141 as a prereq. Thus, this is not so much as change in prereqs; we are simply making the Math 141 prereq more explicit. Secondly, we are removing the unrequisite of Biology 413, which is a course that no longer exists.
