# 2. Relationship to mission and strategic plan of institution, and/or college and department goals and objectives:

The goals of the college and department are to offer students a curriculum that is current and include developments within the field. Restorative Justice is a recent and increasingly used method of conflict resolution and of law offender treatment-rehabilitation.

The goals of the college and department include offering students a global perspective and prepare students to be global citizens. Contemporary Chinese Society contributes to these goals.

3. **Rationale:** The **SOCIOLGY 375** Restorative Justice course is being added to Group 4 (Law, Criminology) and will broaden the instruction on alternative ways to resolve conflict and address acts committed by offenders. The **SOCIOLGY 351** course is being added to Group 5 (Global, Comparative) to expand the coverage of non-Western societies.

#### 4. Cost Implications:

The SOCIOLOGY 375 Restorative Justice course will be taught by an instructional academic instructor staff member who previously taught SOCIOLOGY 265, Race & Ethnic Relations.

A new faculty member has been hired who now teaches that course regularly. This will free up the academic staff member to teach the Restorative Justice once each spring. SOCIOLOGY 351 Contemporary Chinese Society will be taught by a faculty member who previously taught SOCIOLOGY 350. Another faculty member has added SOCIOLOGY 350 to her course rotation, freeing up replace it with SOCIOLOGY 351.
