SOCIOLOGY, Honors Emphasis, Bachelor of Arts**

The Major Planning Guide is a sample program which illustrates the type of curriculum a new freshman will take to complete the degree in 4 years; it is not an official document. All students must complete a minimum of 120 credits including:

- 1) At least 32 units of general education, including specific Gen Ed core courses, as well as approved math and science, physical education, and elective courses. Your general education electives must come from the following categories: GA, GS, GH, GE, or GI.
- 2) All requirements for the BA or BS Degree.
- 3) All requirements for the major and minor (if required)

* Test scores determine placement in Math and English courses. Refer to the AAR for this information and then adjust this schedule accordingly. The Planning Guide begins with the most common placement for this major.

** Bachelor of Arts students must demonstrate that they have achieved basic competency in a foreign language equivalent to one year of study at the college level. Students must also complete two 300/400 level courses outside of the major and minor subjects.

† These group courses may be taken in any order.

Courses in **Bold** indicate specific courses that must be completed for the major. Other courses such as Gened Courses or major/minor electives can be selected from a number of course choices. NOTE: This major does not require a minor.
