	Submit an official high school transcript Submit official copies of all College / University transcripts		Students from UW Colleges should dually enroll at both UW-Whitewater and UW colleges during last semester in attendance at UW Colleges. Students should enroll in the UW-Whitewater EDFOUND 214 (Portfolio) 1 credit course. (Not required for Early Childhood)
