1. Call to Order: Chair Erdmann called the meeting to order at 2:29 p.m.
2. Roll Call
 - a. 3. Approval of Minutes of April 9, 2002 Faculty Senate: Wentz/Dollarhide moved approval as corrected. Passed.
4. Reports of Committees
 - a. University Curriculum Committee
 - i. Transmittal of actions of Friday, April 5, 2002, Ellenwood/Topp moved approval of actionable items. Passed. **FS0102-36**
 - ii. Transmittal of actions of Friday, April 19, 2002, Topp/Ahmadi moved approval of actionable items. Passed. **FS0102-37**
 - b. Committee on UWW Free Speech Policy (Molloy) (attached as "Assemblies, Rallies, Parades, Pickets and Demonstrations".): Molloy/Ellenwood moved to approve the policy document.
 - i. De Onis/Klug moved to recommend to the committee that the language changed throughout the document to *the building supervisor or police services* be restored to original ("university official or officials", or "authorized official"), accepting Hogan's suggestion that the committee accompany the original language with parenthetical specifics indicating the authorized official(s). Passed.
 - ii. Oravec/Epps moved to recommend that the committee clarify and provide detail about the Office of Leadership Development's processing of off-campus groups' requests, especially adding a timeframe for processing, such as "as soon as feasible." Passed.
 - iii. Phanord/Oravec moved to postpone the item indefinitely. Motion to postpone indefinitely failed.
 - iv. Parks/Dollarhide moved to instruct the Senate Chair to forward the Senate's recommendations to the committee. Passed.
 - v. Kozlowicz/Stinson moved that the Senate affirm its commitment to free speech, encouraging the committee to examine policies that maximize free speech without restrictions, and suggesting that the committee address language of sUWS 18 and sUWS 21 in the light of the Senate's concerns toward the end of recommending to the Board of Regents amendments to sUWS 18 and sUWS 21. Failed.

As amended and passed, the motion reads:

The UW-Whitewater Faculty Senate approves the proposed policy on "Assemblies, Rallies, Parades, Pickets and Demonstrations" with the recommendations that:

1) the committee restore language throughout the document referring to "the building supervisor or police services" to the language of UWS 18 and 21, with added parenthetical references indicating who serves as the authorized official(s); and that

2) insofar as practicable, the committee specify procedures and expeditious time limits for the Office of Leadership Development's processing of off-campus groups' requests.

*The Senate further instructs that the Senate Chair forward the Senate's recommendations to the committee. **FS0102-38***
