WHY STUDY ABROAD?

Psychology is the scientific study of the mind and behavior. Study abroad gives psychology majors to observe and gain an understanding of human behavior in a non-US context, both inside and outside the classroom. Study abroad participants also develop cross-cultural communication, problem-solving, and language skills that are highly sought-after in many careers.

ACADEMICS

Psychology majors considering studying abroad are advised to work with their academic advisor to identify the best time to study abroad, based on the student's degree requirements and the courses offered on the study abroad program of the student's choice.

Some psychology courses abroad may be evaluated as equivalent to particular UW-Whitewater courses. Additionally, many study abroad programs offer unique psychology coursework that may not be offered at UW-Whitewater and which may be used as psychology electives within the major with departmental approval.

In addition to satisfying major requirements, students may also fulfil minor, foreign language, or breadth requirements abroad.
