Some of these will be locally-generated, and others will be collected from the public domain.
- 2. Students have increased ownership of their own learning through creation and use of the LibEd.

- 1. Continue creating a library of "stories from the trenches:" short lectures and audio recordings (LibEd talks) by diverse P-12 and higher ed practitioners that discuss methodologies and practices that can deepen student learning. Some of these will be locally-generated, others will be collected from the public domain.
- 2. Impact the culture of COEPS by providing access to a wide range of highly engaging talks supporting COEPS and department missions.
- 3. Participating students will have increased ownership of their own learning through creation and use of the LibEd: *Student empowerment--LEAP workshop theme*.
- 4. Students will have increased opportunities for critical thinking and analysis (ELO)
