within.** You'll see a wall-mounted clear box with a  
piece that can be removed and inserted into the floor,

**The goal is to improve security and to provide

room, all University Police are equipped with a tool that  
can remove the barricade from the outside.

# Nightlock Lockdown Instructions



Remove device from case.



Position T-shaped edge over T-shaped groove on door.



Slide down until device locks into place.
