Position Summary

The Warhawk Alley Pin Chaser is the primary resource for bowling lane maintenance and upkeep. Stationed in the mechanic area, Pin Chasers are expected to repair most lanes as problems arise during peak hours of use. The Pin Chaser is essential to the daily operations of Warhawk Alley. Primary duties include making sure that Warhawk Alley machinery is well kept and issues that may arise are handled quickly and effectively. Training is essential to this position. Some operations can become high risk if not properly maintained.
