RE: **Covered Charges for Safety Glasses**

This memo is to inform you of the covered charges for safety glasses by the State of Wisconsin contract and the employees Union/Management agreement effective May 2007.

The University will pay the following maximum amounts during the life of the contract:

- \$20 per pair of lenses
- \$25 per pair of frames
- \$5 toward lens enhancements, such as tinting, shading, ultraviolet coating, etc.

The employee is responsible for all additional costs. He/she has a list of the charges and should share them with you.

As the eye care provider, please complete the bottom half of the A.O. Safety prescription eyewear order form beginning with the patient's last and first name and ending with the signature lines. Please give the order form back to the employee as FP&M is responsible for submitting the order form to A.O. Safety.

All employees are encouraged, but not required, to take their prescriptions to Davis Duehr-Dean, Dr. Gerald Theune, 128 N. Tratt Street, Whitewater, where there is a complete selection of sample frames available from A.O. Safety.

Please be advised that the invoice for the eye exam should be sent to the patient's health insurance provider, if applicable, or mailed to:

University of Wisconsin-Whitewater DOES NOT pay for Titanium frames unless it is the **ONLY** item a person can wear. With the exception that Contrast 100, Contrast 200, DT-1, DT-2, DT-3, DT-4, EXT-1 and EXT-5, SW02, SW03, Xss1001 **ARE** covered as of **01/01/2007-12/31/2008**.

TRIVEX, which is the most resistant lens material available, costs an additional \$25 for SV and BIF price and \$50 to Love II PAL price.

TL1 and TL2 are only available with Trivex lens material. No additional charge for Trivex – included in frame price.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR OBTAINING SAFETY GLASSES

All forms relating to safety glasses are available on line from the Facilities Planning and Management home page at <http://www.uww.edu/adminaffairs/fpm/index.html>. Specifically, the following forms must be downloaded prior to an employee's scheduled appointment with his/her eye care provider:

- A.O. Safety Eyewear Order Form
- UW-Whitewater Memo to Health Care Providers Re: Covered Charges for Safety Glasses
- A.O. Safety Cost Breakdowns sheet dated July 2008

The employee should have all three forms available during their appointment for use or reference by the eye care provider. The employee's supervisor should sign the eyewear order form prior to the employee's scheduled medical appointment. The eye care provider must complete the bottom half of the order form beginning with the patient's name and ending with the signature lines. The order form must be returned to FP&M by the employee after the prescription information is completed so we can submit it to A.O. Safety.

Employees may see the eye care provider of their choice. However, a complete selection of sample frames from A.O. Safety is available only at the office of Dr. Gerald Theune, 128 N. Tratt Street, Whitewater.
