

University of Wisconsin - Whitewater
Payment Plan Agreement
Spring 2011 Term

By checking "I Agree", I have read and agree to the terms contained herein. I am entering into this agreement which will become effective on the date captured by my electronic signature. This agreement is applicable for the Spring 2011 term.

I would like to enroll in and attend classes at the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater (UWW). In order to remain registered and attend classes, UWW requires that I pay in full by the due date indicated, the amount of any fees, tuition, housing and meal plan costs, and other miscellaneous charges on my student account. Although all amounts owed are payable on the due date, UWW recognizes that students, including myself, may not make such payments in full by the due date. At its discretion and if certain requirements are met, UWW will allow me to pay certain past due amounts pursuant to an installment payment plan (the Payment Plan).

I am being asked to sign this agreement now so that in the event that I am unable to pay the entire balance of eligible charges (segregated fees, tuition, room, and meal plans) by the term due date, UWW may activate the installment Payment Plan for me.

Access UWW will provide me with access to an on-line Whitewater WINS account. Through my WINS account, I will be able to view my student account information and amounts owed by me to UWW and the due dates (including payment plan due dates) for such amounts. Access to the billing and on-line payment process is made available via a link from my student account.

Withdrawal Should I choose to withdraw from the term for which I have registered, I will complete the withdrawal process as found on the UWW Registrar's website <http://www.uww.edu/registrar/>

Should I choose not to be on the Payment Plan after I sign this agreement, I can rescind this agreement by sending a communication to the Student Accounts office at sfs@uww.edu prior to the start of the applicable term.

The Payment Plan

(1) At its discretion, UWW may activate the Spring Payment Plan if my account has a remaining balance for eligible charges after the published term due date and time has passed.

(2) A non-refundable \$50 activation fee (the Payment Plan Fee) will be added to my account after the term due date has passed if the Spring Payment Plan is activated.

(3) Eligible charges for the Payment Plan consist of tuition, segregated fees, housing and meal plan charges. All other charges to my student account are NOT eligible and are payable by the due date indicated on my bill.

(4) The Payment Plan consists of two required installment payments. The first and second payments are due on the dates indicated on my bill for such payments. The first payment is typically four weeks after the term due date and the second typically four weeks later. I will check my student bill for the specific due dates.

(5) If the total of any amounts placed on the Payment Plan changes, UWW will adjust the payment amounts for the change; but depending on the timing of the change, only the final payment may be adjusted.

(6) I can pay off the Payment Plan amounts at any time in advance of the due dates.

(7) Amounts placed on the Payment Plan will not incur finance charges, and my classes will not be at risk for cancellation unless and until I miss an installment payment. A missed payment will result in finance charges being applied to my account and put me at risk for cancellation of classes.

(8) UWW has the right to deny participation in the Payment Plan for any semester without further notice to me. Should I be denied participation in the Payment Plan and feel there are extenuating circumstances, I can request special consideration by contacting the Bursar at sfs@uww.edu.

(9) In the event of default on my account, I agree to pay all attorney fees, collection costs, finance charges and fees associated with the collection of past due amounts.

(10) Marital Property Act - I understand that if I am married, credit will not be extended to me under this Agreement unless I complete the Marital Property information.

(11) I agree that I have read and understand the terms of this Agreement and that I am at least 18 years of age. Underage students should contact the Student Accounts Office.
