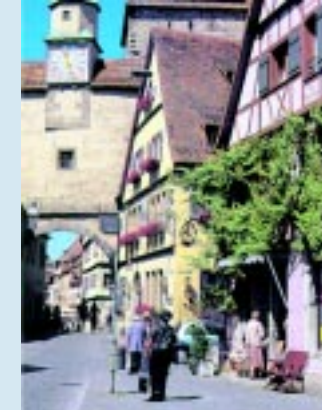
Monterrey, Mexico



The main campus for the ITESM 26-campus system is located in Monterrey.

Other campuses with programs for international students are in Cuernavaca, Guadalajara, Mazatlan, Mexico City and Queretaro. You may take courses in intensive Spanish, business in Mexico, hotel and tourism, Mexican history and culture. Regular courses are taught at various levels of proficiency in Spanish.

Hessen University, Germany



At Hessen University in Germany, all courses are taught in German. Students may choose from one of three campuses in different German cities. Courses range from art, business, computer science, social science, media studies and German. You will be enrolled for 4-5 courses during spring term or two classes during summer term.

..... Dublin, Ireland

This program is designed for journalism majors or minors at Dublin City University. You will learn about the history and culture of Ireland while completing required courses in print and broadcast journalism. Students typically live with families in Dublin or the surrounding university area.



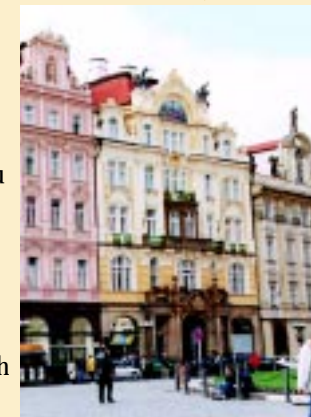
..... Bern, Switzerland

Located in the heart of Europe, the University of Bern dates back to 1528. You may select from a variety of courses taught in English through the English and economics departments. German and French language courses are also available. During holidays and breaks you can easily reach much of Europe by express trains leaving from Bern.



..... Brno, Czech Republic

With instruction in English, the program at Brno University of Technology is designed to offer internships for students with senior managers in a variety of high-technology or international firms. You will serve as an English - speaking resource advisor to top managers. Seminars focus on accounting, economics, finance, management or marketing topics. Share an apartment with other exchange students or Czech students for one or two semesters.



..... Umeå, Sweden

Umeå is the "cultural capital" of northern Sweden, long known as "swinging Umeå" with its many pubs, restaurants, theatres, concerts, cinemas and more. Outdoor opportunities include skiing, fishing, rafting, canoeing and hiking. Umeå University has 22,000 students. You may select from a wide range of business and social science courses that are taught in English.



Hirakata, Osaka, Japan



Located in the heart of cultural Japan, Kansai Gaidai University is a private nonprofit institution which enrolls over 13,000 students. It is an excellent starting point for exploring the cities of Osaka, a center of pop culture, and Kyoto, the ancient capital of Japan. Classes are taught in English and Japanese which include culture, society, business and Japanese language. A background in Japanese/Asian studies is recommended. Students may live with a Japanese family, on-campus or independently off-campus.

Tokyo, Japan



Sophia University is located in Tokyo, Japan's capital city. The roots go back to 1549, when Francis Xavier landed in Japan. Courses are taught in English in the areas of business, Letters & Sciences and Asian studies.

Arnhem, The Netherlands



Windmills, tulips, cheese, castles, Van Gogh - cultural Holland is yours to explore when attending the University of Arnhem. Business majors or minors can choose from a variety of subjects which are taught in English. To apply for the program, you must be at least a junior.

The state of Victoria, Australia ...



Deakin University is located in the beautiful city of Melbourne, Victoria with three campuses at different cities in Victoria. Three

unique programs of study are available: *Marine Biology and Freshwater Ecology* - This campus at Warrnambool is in a picturesque coastal town located on the spectacular Great Ocean Road. The area is a major summer resort destination with miles of beaches. Student applicants must be majoring in biology with a marine biology/freshwater ecology emphasis. *Journalism* - Centered at the campus at Geelong, a city of 100,000, journalism majors will take at least four courses over two semesters and be assigned an internship at a newspaper, radio, or television station. *The International Exchange Program* - This is a more general program for one semester only. You must have a major or minor in either the College of Arts and Communication or the College of Letters and Sciences.

Jönköping, Sweden



The city of Jönköping is over 700 years old and has traces of dwelling sites that date back to the Stone Age. Today it is the center of business, commercial and innovative communications companies. The university enrolls over 8,000 students and through its international business school has programs for exchange students in management, economics and finance taught in English.

Jyväskylä, Finland.....



"A small city with a big feel" accurately describes Jyväskylä, located in the lake district of Finland about 150 miles north of Helsinki. It has the advantages of a small town, being comfortable and safe yet at the same time it is a bustling center of industry and learning. Out of the city's 140,000 inhabitants, almost one fifth are students at the university. You may spend a semester in Finland completing courses

taught in English through the University of Jyväskylä's Communications Department.

Travel Study Programs & Student Teaching Opportunities

A variety of credit bearing short term study courses and service learning experiences are offered each year, typically during the summer and winter breaks. Past destinations have included Jamaica, Cuba, England, Scotland, France, West Africa and South Africa. Student teaching placements are available in Australia, Jamaica and Sweden during fall and spring terms. Other UW System Study Abroad programs offer additional opportunities for you to study almost anything, anywhere in the world!

Sunshine and a warm climate make Jamaica a desirable location in which to learn during the two annual travel study programs to this beautiful country. The travel study program offered during the winter is open to anyone interested in learning about Jamaica. You will study the Jamaican educational system, economy, landscape and culture by visiting private and public schools, banana and coffee plantations, caves and waterfalls, the Bob Marley Museum and more.

The service learning travel study program to Jamaica in early summer is open to all majors and allows you to experience the Jamaican public school system firsthand as a tutor in addition to providing you with a brief overview of Jamaican history and issues related to life in a developing nation.
