UW-W ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP  
(a.k.a Outstanding Junior Award)  
Instructions

This Award is presented to the most outstanding junior in the College of Letters & Sciences as determined by a committee chosen by the Letters & Sciences faculty. The annual amount of the award is \$1,000.

To be eligible, students must be an accepted registered student at UW-W holding junior status (60-89.9 course credits) at the time of application, have declared a major in the College of Letters & Sciences, have the support of the department of their major, and provide solid evidence of leading an outstanding, scholarly life. If the Award recipient voluntarily discontinues his or her UW-W education s/he shall forfeit all right of the Award and the money shall revert to the fund.

1. A fully completed application form.
2. A letter of support from the Chair of the student's major department.
3. A copy of the student's academic report (AR).

\* If sending via email, title the subject line of the email as follows: "junior" followed by a hyphen, the student's last name followed by a hyphen, and the student's first name (i.e. junior-doe-john).

Application Deadline is 4:00 P.M. on February 1<sup>st</sup>.

*Note about deadline: If February 1<sup>st</sup> falls on a Friday, Saturday or Sunday, the application deadline will be extended to 9:00 A.M. of the Monday following February 1.*
