METCALF FAMILY ENDOWMENT

This scholarship was established by Robert Metcalf, an attendee of the University of Wisconsin – Whitewater, in memory of his wife, Christine McLean Metcalf, a graduate of the 1945 class of University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, formerly known as Whitewater State Teachers College, and their daughter Dale Ann. Dale Ann was a graduate of University of Texas, with a degree in mathematics and computer sciences. She was an aeronautical engineer at Lockheed martin International, and chief engineer on the F-117 stealth fighter. Christine was the mother of Dale Ann and Scott Metcalf, and a lifelong advocate of learning and reading. She was active in community affairs as the wife of an Air Force office.

This scholarship shall be made only to female students enrolled at the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater, who have a declared major in either science or mathematics. The candidate must possess and maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0 and be a junior or senior at the time of the award. The scholarship is renewable, but the candidate must resubmit an application and complete the selection process each year.

To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must submit the following:

1. A completed application form including a personal statement which demonstrates the student's academic scholarship in mathematics or the sciences, and financial need;

2. A copy of the applicant's Academic Report (AR); and
3. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member in the student's major.
