PROMISE ENDOWMENT

This fund was established by UW-Whitewater alumnae, Mary (Tina) Pregont '80 and her husband, Joseph Pregont, to assist meritorious UW-Whitewater College of Letters & Sciences students who come from a large metropolitan area and have demonstrated financial need. Preference will be given to students who are first generation college students. The annual amount of the award is \$500 and is renewable contingent upon successful reapplication and selection. To be eligible, students must be an accepted registered student at UW-W holding sophomore, junior, or senior status at the time of application; have declared a major in the College of Letters & Sciences; provide evidence of a lack sufficient financial support for the needs associated with providing room and board; and maintain a minimum GPA of 2.7.

To be considered for the Award, students must submit the following:

1. A completed application form including a personal statement which addresses the student's:
 - a. Origination from a major metropolitan area;
 - b. Involvement in campus community;
 - c. Citizenship and character; and
 - d. Financial need.
2. A copy of the applicant's Academic Report (AR).
3. Two letters of recommendation from UW-Whitewater faculty or staff members.
