**BSE HISTORY WITH SOCIAL STUDIES EMPHASIS**  
**Major - 57 Units**

Select 36 Units in History Distributed as Follows:

1. U.S. History –

A. Early U.S. History. Select 6 units: HISTRY-124, 300, 301, 304, 313, 316, and 324.

B. Modern U.S. History. Select 6 units: HISTRY 102, 125, 141, 305, 306, 307, 311, 314, 317, 362, 390, 394, 401, 403, 415, 425, and CHCN 310.

2. European History:

A. Early European History. Select 3-6 units: HISTRY-154, 353, 354, 355, 360, 371, 380, 354, and 353.

B. Modern European History. Select 3-6 units: HISTRY-155, 351, 352, 360, 367, 372, 375, 381, and 460.

3. African, Asian, Latin American, or Middle Eastern History. Select 3-6 units: HISTRY-130, 131, 340, 342, 343, 346, 347, 432, 433 and 434.

4. Comparative and Global History. Select 0-6 units: HISTRY-150, 165, 190, 326, 335, 360, 367.

5. Methods Courses: HISTRY-200 AND 499.

6. A Maximum of 15 Units in 100 Level History Courses May Count Towards the Major.

7. Select 9-12 Units From Two of the Following Departments for a Total of 21 Units:

A. Select 9-12 Units From the Geography, Excluding: GEOGRPY-210, 300, 310, 320, 323, 330, and 450. At least 3 units must be chosen from GEOGRPY-230, 250, and 252.

B. Select 9-12 Units From Political Science. At least 3 units must be chosen from: POLISCI-141 or 250.

C. Select 9-12 Units From Economics, Excluding ECON-245 and 345. At least 3 units must be chosen from: ECON-202 or 213.

D. Select 9-12 Units From Psychology, Excluding PSYCH-215. At least 3 units must be chosen from: PSYCH-104, 202 or 211.

E. Select 9-12 Units From Sociology. At least 3 units must be chosen from: SOCIOLGY-140 or 250.

Note: The following courses must be personalized into the appropriate category: HISTRY 110, 291, 422, 455, 490, 491, 492, 496, 498—consult your advisor regarding personalization of these courses.

Unique Requirement (5-6 units)

1. Arts or Literature: Select 2-3 units from ARTHIST 201, 202, 305, 311 thru 319; MUSC 140, 143, 144, 244 thru 247; THTR 100, 110; ENGLISH 200 thru 265.

2. Social Sciences: Select 3 units from ECON 201, 202, 213; GEOGRPY 230; POLISCI 250, 217, 247; ANTHROPL 110, 218.
