**BA/BS HISTORY WITH PUBLIC HISTORY EMPHASIS**  
**Major - 36 Units**

1. HISTRY 200 and HISTRY 499
2. Introductory Level (100s-200s, excluding HISTRY 200): Select at least 9 units.
3. Upper Level (300s-400s): Select at least 15 units in addition to # 1 and # 2 above.
4. Applied History: HISTRY 493 - Select at least 3 units.
5. The courses chosen to complete requirements #2 and #3 must satisfy the following breadth and depth requirements:

A. Geographical/Thematic Breadth. Select at least 3 units in each of the following groups:

1. European History: HISTRY-154, 155, 351, 352, 353, 354, 355, 371, 372, 375, 380, 381, or 460.
2. African, Asian, Latin American, or Middle Eastern History: HISTRY-130, 131, 340, 342, 343, 346, 347, 432, 433, and 434.
3. U.S. History: HISTRY-102, 124, 125, 141, 300, 301, 304, 305, 306, 307, 311, 313, 314, 316, 317, 324, 362, 390, 394, 401, 403, 415, 425, and CHCN 310.
4. Global/Comparative: HISTRY-150, 165, 190, 326, 335, 360, 367.

B. Geographical/Thematic Depth. Select at least 9 additional units in one of the following groups:

1. European History: HISTRY-154, 155, 351, 352, 353, 354, 355, 371, 372, 375, 380, 381, or 460.
2. African, Asian, Latin American, or Middle Eastern History: HISTRY-130, 131, 340, 342, 343, 346, 347, 432, 433 and 434.
3. U.S. History: HISTRY-102, 124, 125, 141, 300, 301, 304, 305, 306, 307, 311, 313, 314, 316, 317, 324, 362, 390, 394, 401, 403, 415, 425, and CHCN 310.
4. Individually Designed Thematic Concentration. Requires History Department Approval.
