Saturday, May 2, 2009

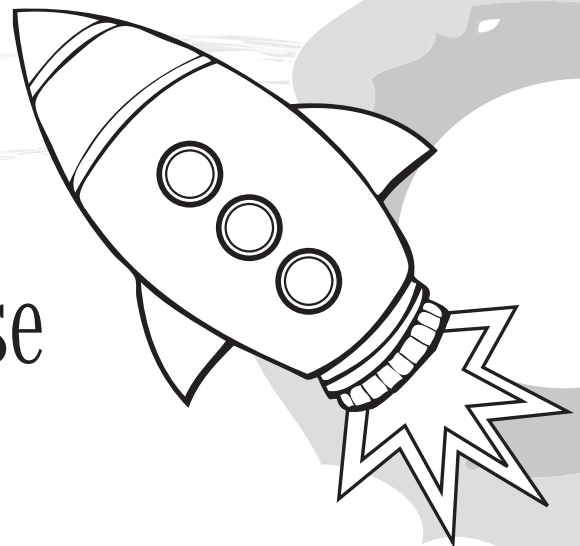
