

## ABOUT THE CAMP

The UW-Whitewater Flute Camp provides flutists (entering 8th grade through those graduating from high school) an opportunity to grow musically and to hear and learn a new repertoire. The daily schedule challenges the student at his or her own personal level. In addition to two daily lessons, flute quartet and warm-up sessions, campers enroll in two or more of the class offerings. On the last two days of the camp week, private flute lessons are joined by professional accompanists.

## INSURANCE

Each camper will be covered by a limited accident insurance policy. The insurance includes primary coverage up to \$7,500 and \$300 maximum dental insurance. Insurance does not cover pre-existing injuries and is for accidents only. The cost of insurance is included in the registration fee.

## CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS

“Honor Camper” and “Outstanding Camper” scholarships are awarded on the last day of Flute Camp which can be applied toward next year’s camp fee.

## ABOUT THE DIRECTOR

Camp Director Robin Fellows is a Professor of Music at the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater. He is principal flutist of the Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra and the Summer Woodstock Mozart Festival Orchestra, second flutist and piccoloist of the Milwaukee Ballet Orchestra, and the flutist in the Whitewater Wind Quintet.



He has performed with the Madison Symphony Orchestra, Nashville Symphony Orchestra, and Knoxville Symphony Orchestra. Dr. Fellows previously taught at Tennessee Tech University, Northwestern University, and Connecticut College. He has judged competitions, served on or chaired panels at various N.F.A. Conventions, and has performed at eight National Flute Association Conventions.

Dr. Fellows has published articles in “Flute Talk” and “The Flutist Quarterly” magazines and has recorded on the Marc, Audio for the Arts and Stoic labels. He can be heard on three CDs as the principal flutist of the Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra. His solo CD, entitled “Twentieth Century Music for Flute,” received an excellent review in “Flute Talk” magazine. Dr. Fellow’s edition entitled “Celebrated Works for Flute by French Composers”, published by Progress Press, was recently released. Dr. Fellows received a Doctorate of Music degree from Northwestern University, a Master of Music degree from the Cleveland Institute of Music, and a Bachelor of Music degree from the Crane School of Music (S.U.N.Y. Potsdam).
