Warhawk Youth Soccer Camp (Residential)

Ages: 10-13 (grades 4-8)

Warhawk High School Soccer Camp (Residential)

Dates: July 15-18, 2012
Ages: 14-18 (grades 9-12)

Both the Youth Soccer Camp, and the High School Soccer Camp, maintain separate boys and girls programs.

THE FOCUS OF WARHAWK SOCCER

The UWW residential soccer camp is designed to develop and enhance the well-rounded player. The UW-Whitewater Warhawk Soccer Camp combines a strong emphasis on individual skills along with advanced team tactics. In the morning, field players will receive training in techniques of dribbling, passing, receiving and finishing. Individual creativity is strongly encouraged among our campers to produce confidence while playing the game of soccer. The afternoon schedule concentrates on the tactical development of the individual player. Each tactical session will conclude with a 8v8 or 11v11 tournament match allowing players the opportunity to apply the tactical lessons in a game setting with further instruction on team tactics and strategies provided by a team coach. Each evening session will entail small-sided games allowing each player to utilize the skills learned throughout the day. In addition to field instruction, the Warhawk Soccer Camp provides opportunities for campers to further advance their understanding of the game through a series of lectures, question-and-answer sessions, and the latest films and videos.

CAMP FEES

The camp fee is \$325 and includes all meals, housing, insurance, instruction, recreation and a camp t-shirt.



WHAT TO BRING

Residential campers need to bring: towels, twin-sized sheets (or sleeping bag), pillow, alarm clock, toiletries, etc. In addition, campers need to have appropriate dress for activities: t-shirt, shorts, socks, and shoes.

Greg Henschel is the Head Men's and Women's Coach at UW-Whitewater. He has led the Warhawks to 11 NCAA tournament appearances including NCAA Round of 16 appearances in 1999, 2001, 2002, 2010 & 2011. Henschel was named WIAC Men's Coach of the Year in 2009 after leading the Warhawks to the inaugural WIAC Conference Championship. In 2011 Henschel was named WIAC Men's and Women's Coach of the Year as both teams captured the WIAC regular season championships and participated in the NCAA Tournament. He holds a licensure from the United States Soccer Federation (USSF). Henschel has over 15 years of experience directing and instructing soccer camps across the country.
