ALL SKILLS CAMPS

- Camp 1 • July 8-11 • Sun.-Wed. (grades 5-12)
- Camp 2 • July 11-14 • Wed.-Sat. (grades 5-12)
- Camp 3 • July 15-18 • Sun.-Wed. (grades 5-12)

These all-around camps focus on the skills needed for volleyball from beginning to advanced levels. All Skill sessions focus on skill and technique development. Camps also focus on refinement of techniques through the incorporation of games and competitive play. Campers are divided into ability groups from beginning to advanced levels through a skill testing evaluation. The final sessions of the camp focus on utilizing all of these skills during a fun and competitive tournament. Graduating seniors are also eligible to attend.

POSITION CAMP

July 18-21 • Wed.-Sat. (grades 8-12)

This specialized camp focuses on skill development and refinement as well as tactical application specific to the positions of left and right side hitter, middle hitter, setter, and libero. Campers are divided by position and ability level from intermediate to advanced. Skill sessions focus on position specific technique training while incorporating games and competitive play. All positions will be brought together in the final sessions for tournament play. Graduating seniors are also eligible to attend.

CAMP FEES

INSURANCE

Each camper will be covered by a limited accident insurance policy. The insurance includes primary coverage up to \$7,500 and \$300 maximum dental insurance. Insurance does not cover pre-existing injuries and is for accidents only. The cost of insurance is included in the registration fee. Every precaution will be taken to prevent accidents. Our camp will have a camp health supervisor available.

WHAT TO BRING

About 2–3 weeks prior to the start of each camp, specific instructions for reporting to camp and what to bring will be sent to participants.

FACILITIES

The Warhawk Volleyball Camps are conducted on the beautiful campus of UW-Whitewater. Campers will have use of recreational facilities including the Williams Center and Kachel Fieldhouse. The Williams Center offers four gyms, a state-of-the-art weight room, and swimming/diving facilities. The 60,000 square foot Kachel Fieldhouse is one of the finest facilities in the country. It features four volleyball courts and an indoor running track.

HOUSING & FOOD

The residence halls are within walking distance of the Williams Center volleyball arenas and offer comfortable residence hall living. Campers will be housed two to a room in single beds and must provide their own linens (sleeping bags are preferred). The dining hall is located in close proximity to the residence halls and serves well-balanced meals. For dining variety, some meals will be held off-campus in a park adjacent to campus. All off-campus meals are supervised by camp staff. Commuter campers at all camps are entitled to lunch and dinner. These meals are included in the camp fee. Check-in information and residence hall designation will be mailed to registered campers 2-3 weeks prior to the start of camp.

Stacy Boudreau HEAD COACH

Stacy has led the Warhawks to 7 NCAA appearances in her 7 seasons coaching including a National Championship in 2005, a third place finish in 2006 and a National Runner-up Finish in 2007. Boudreau's overall record at UW-Whitewater is 226-49. She was named the 2005 AVCA NCAA Division III National Coach of the Year and the 2007 WIAC Coach of the Year. Boudreau came to UW-Whitewater from Iowa Wesleyan College where she was the Head Coach for three seasons. She directed IWC to an overall record of 70-37, winning two conference championships, and finishing tied for ninth in the 2004 NAIA National Tournament. She was named AVCA NAIA Region Coach of the Year in 2004 and MCC Coach of the Year in 2003. Along with directing Warhawk Volleyball Camps, Boudreau has over 10 years of experience directing and instructing various camps and clinics across the Midwest.



Ben Staupé ASSISTANT COACH

Ben is the Assistant Volleyball coach at UW-W. In Ben's second year, he helped the Warhawks to their 20th consecutive NCAA tournament appearance. Prior to coming to Whitewater, he was the head coach at Rock Valley College for 8 seasons. He is a 2-time Region and District Coach of the Year, and 4-time Conference Coach of the Year. His teams took the National Runner-up Finish in 2004 and 5th in 2007. He has won 4 conference titles with an overall record of 202-91. He has coached Club Volleyball with Club Fusion-Marengo and Club Fusion Rockford, and has directed and instructed camps throughout the Midwest.

CAMP STAFF

Along with the UW-Whitewater Coaching Staff, the Warhawk Volleyball Camps' staff includes top instructors in the Midwest featuring top college, high school, and club coaches, as well as current and former college players and Warhawk greats. We provide one coach for every eight participants. We believe that with this ratio we can develop the talents of each camper and spend adequate time teaching and refining skills.
