General Participation Guidelines

The Participant Handbook is long! Take an abbreviated look at the following emphasized general policies (in no particular order) to help guide your Intramural Sports participation:

No ID = No Play

All participants must show a valid HawkCard in order to check in for a contest. Don't have your card, ask us about a forgotten ID pass!

EligibilityAll team members must be on a team's roster and meet eligibility standards

set by Intramural Sports and The Office of Recreation Sports & Facilities

Participant Quiz & Waiver Each team member must pass the participant quiz and acknowledge the

online waiver in order to be added to a team's roster

Sportsmanship & Conduct Active participants, bench personnel and spectators are expected to

practice positive sportsmanship, including bench decorum, at all times

Team NamesTeam names must be appropriate and cannot be competitively unfair.

Team names may change at any time via a team's page in IMLeagues

Know Your Activity-Specific Rules Along with the Participant Handbook, each activity has a specific set of

rules. Participants are asked to review rules throughout their involvement

Arrive Early Help keep schedules on-time! Teams are encouraged to arrive 15 minutes

prior to their contest time to properly check in and prepare to participate

Forfeits Teams are expected to arrive for all scheduled contests. Failure to attend

may result in a contest loss, poor sportsmanship standing and a fee

Proper AttirePlease wear attire that is distinguishable from opponents and proper

footwear (including non-marking shoes inside and no metal cleats outside)

Equipment Most activity equipment (include a game ball) is provided. Team jerseys and

warm-up equipment may be available for rent from the Equipment Room

IMLeagues The third-party management system for Intramural Sports. All registrations,

roster moves, schedules, brackets and results all take place via IMLeagues

Regular Season Most activities have a regular season with contest minimums. When

registering, teams are mainly registering to have a regular season to play

Results & ProtestsContest results are posted daily in IMLeagues. Teams are welcome to

protest results, eligibility and rule application

Playoffs Activities with a regular season also have a playoff season. Teams must

qualify for playoffs and may not play during their regular season day/time.

throughout your season. Check your email and voicemail regularly!
