The asphalt has significant cracking throughout this area, as well as rutting near the curbs. It currently has a PASER rating of 2. The concrete curb and gutter has settled in some areas and in other areas it has been damaged by snow plows. The road can no longer be patched and has deteriorated beyond repair.
