## Promotions Committee Composition Update

WHEREAS, Article II Section 4 of the Academic Staff Assembly Bylaws establishes the Promotions Review Committee.;

WHEREAS, Academic Staff Assembly is comprised of Academic Staff in both in instructional and noninstructional roles;

WHEREAS, This composition creates a body with diverse experiences and perspectives;
WHEREAS, The current Promotions Review Committee is limited to only those holding instructional titles;

WHEREAS, this limits involvement of those not in instructional roles;
WHEREAS, Most committees have lower membership number requirements;
WHEREAS, The Promotions Committee serves a reviewing and advisory role;
WHEREAS, The number of Instructional Academic Staff applying for promotion varies from year to year;
WHEREAS, Instructional Academic Staff members should maintain a strong voice in their promotions process;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Article II, Section 4 - Promotions Committee Membership be updated to as follows:

- 6 At Least 4 academic staff with instructional status
- For every 4 members of the committee, at least 3 must hold instructional status with the following pattern:

- Chairperson serves as Tabulator during review process and does not review or vote on promotion recommendations, and must hold instructional status.
- 5 All other committee members serve as voting Promotion Reviewers
