PROJECT PURPOSE AND RESULTS

La Voz de Beloit addresses in a decisive, committed, respectful, courageous manner a wide range of themes, focusing especially upon health, safety, and the complete well-being of families within Latino communities. Advanced Spanish Language Study 322 integrates the Community Based Learning component in the classroom. This is a great opportunity for UW-Whitewater students to obtain hands-on experience through intercultural encounters with the Latino community, while developing their communication, analytical, and professional skills. Students will get to know Latino members in Walworth & Rock counties and learn what their needs are, as well as what challenges they face.
