Install Cisco AnyConnect VPN Client - Windows

OVERVIEW

This guide will walk you through the steps to install and launch the Cisco AnyConnect VPN client on your Windows computer.

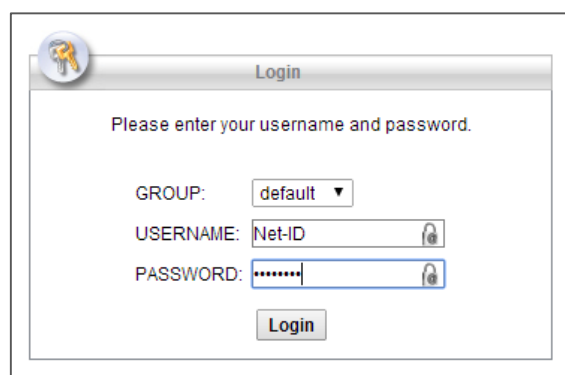
Installing the VPN Client

Step 1

Open a web browser and go to vpn.uww.edu.

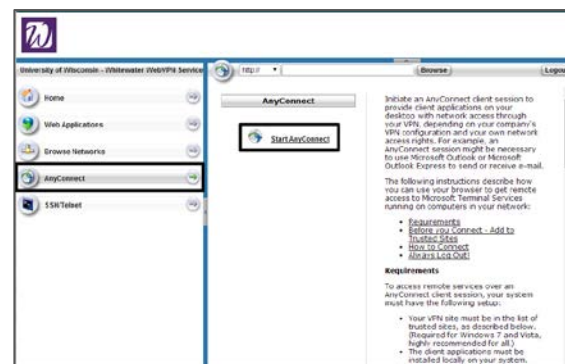
Step 2

Log in with your Net-ID and password. Click the **Login** button to continue.



Step 3

Select "AnyConnect" from the left hand-side toolbar. Next, click **Start AnyConnect**.

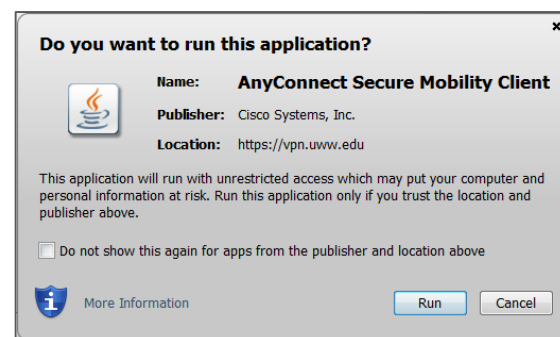


Step 4

You may be prompted to upgrade your version of the Java Runtime Environment. Please do so now. Your version of Java should be version 1.4 or newer.

You may also be asked if you wish to run the AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client. Click **Run** to continue.

If you receive a warning asking if you wish to allow access to the AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client please click **Allow**.

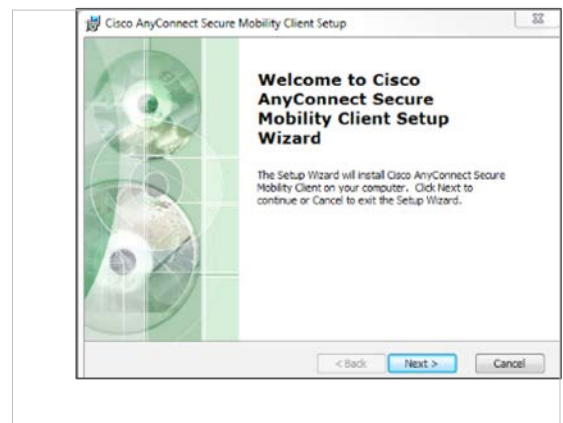


Step 5

If you are prompted to install the Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client, please follow the steps below. Otherwise, continue to step 6.

From the installation window, click **Next** and follow the on-screen instructions to install the Cisco AnyConnect VPN client. If you are prompted to accept the software license agreement, click **Agree** or **Accept**.

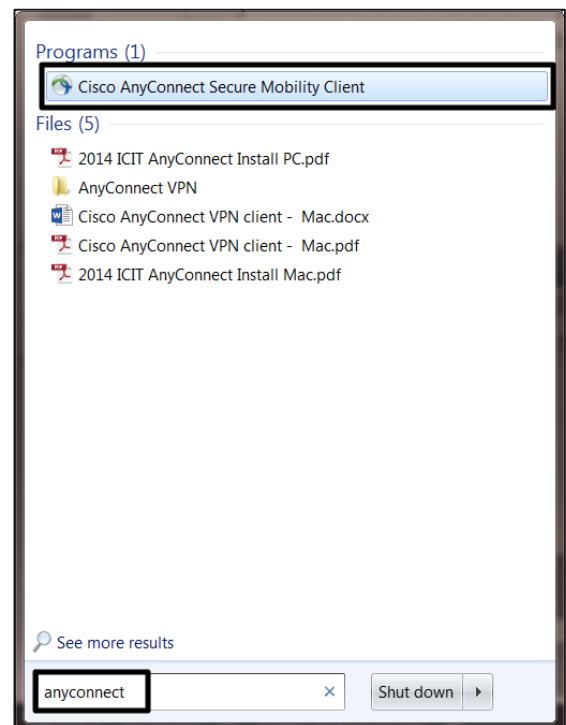
The Cisco VPN client should now launch and connect automatically. If not, please follow the steps below to launch the VPN client.



Launching the VPN Client

Step 1

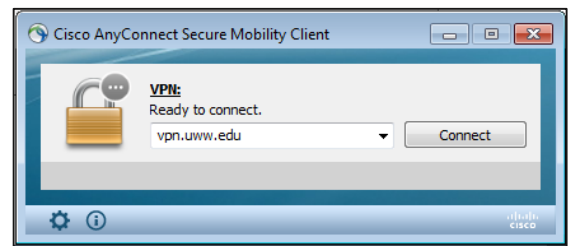
Click **Start**, then search for “AnyConnect”. Select **Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client**.



Step 2

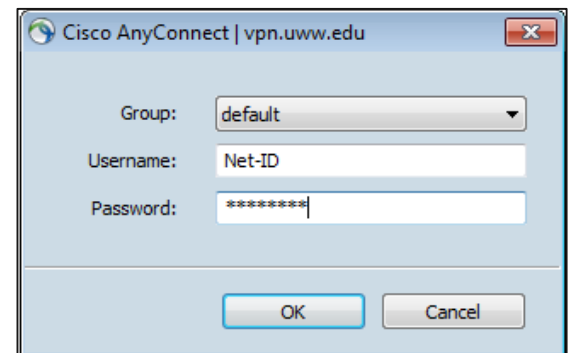
If necessary, type vpn.uww.edu in the text box available.

Click **Connect** to continue.



Step 3

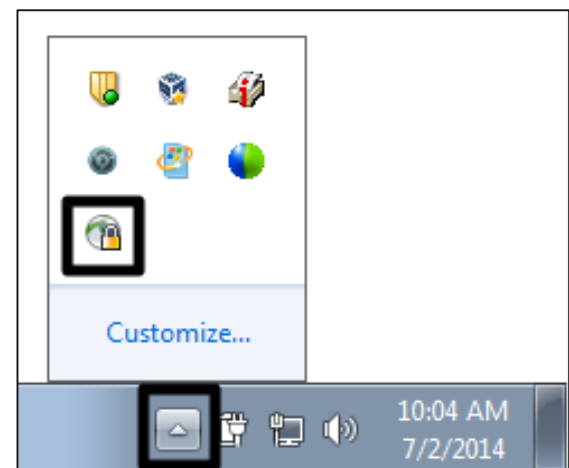
Enter your Net-ID and password. Click **OK** to continue.



A pop up box should now appear telling you that you are successfully connect to the VPN.



To disconnect from the VPN, click on the arrow located in the bottom right-hand corner of your screen. Right click on the Cisco VPN client icon and select **VPN Disconnect**.
