Planned Actions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Begin using position descriptions, self-assessment tool, supervisor’s evaluation tool and letter of recommendation. • Review, evaluate and improve toolkit based on experiences and feedback. • Encourage returning students to share their experiences and LEAP knowledge as mentors to new student employees. • Review and possibly expand the essential learning outcomes achieved through student employment. • Share our experiences with other departments. Encourage campus-wide recognition of student employment as a high-impact practice that contributes to the essential learning outcomes of LEAP. • Continue to encourage and assist student employees in our offices to understand the concept of LEAP and achieve essential learning outcomes. 	
Deliverables, Completed Actions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LEAP Toolkit • Position Descriptions – we have analyzed and reviewed student positions in our offices to create Position Descriptions (PD’s) that summarize job duties as well as incorporate the principles of LEAP. • LEAP Brochure – we created a brochure aimed at managers and supervisors to introduce LEAP principles and how they relate to student jobs. • Self-Evaluation Forms – we developed self-evaluation forms to help student employees assess their own progress toward essential learning outcomes.
