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General Goal:

We have been working to broaden sustainability education across the curriculum by identifying gaps in sustainability education and by providing tools to help faculty incorporate sustainability education into their classes.

Planned Actions:

The Sustainability LEAP Team plans to

- Incorporate (or highlight) the UW System Shared Learning Goal of "environmental responsibility" into the LEAP ELOs by revising them for our own purposes or by highlighting the goal's presence in existing language
- Draft a set of Sustainability Student Learning Outcomes (SSLOs) that meet LEAP ELOs for use by the General Education Reform Committee.
- Develop a one-page framework for a Comprehensive Sustainability Education Plan (CSEP) that merges LEAP principles and Sustainability Education knowledge and practices.
- Partner with the Sustainability Council to complete the STARS 2.0 survey to establish a benchmark for measuring sustainability education gains

Deliverables, Completed Actions:

- Completed 80% of STARS 2.0 Academic Worksheets
- Created Sustainability Student Learning Outcomes (SSLOs) for faculty review and revision.
- Provided SSLOs to the General Education Review Committee for use in current Gen Ed revision.
- Partnered with UWSP researchers on a UW-system-wide sustainability literacy assessment project
