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General Goal: (1) Create teaching materials for an interactive assignment for BEINDP 101 incorporating PRME Principle 1, the UN Global Compact, and UN Sustainable Development Goals. This goal relates to LEAP Principles of Excellence Four through Seven and ELOs: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Knowledge of human cultures and the physical and natural world: Engaging the big questions—the 17 Sustainable Development Goals are aimed at the most important global social and environmental issues • Intellectual and practical skills, specifically: inquiry and analysis into one aspect of corporate social responsibility, written and oral communication (memo and sharing findings), information literacy (learning about societal issues from reputable UN sources), teamwork (students work in teams) (2) Create a PRME packet for student groups and their advisors for broadening the PRME initiative within CoBE and to generate student participation.	
Planned Actions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The CoBE PRME Committee is pursuing outreach to student groups. • Lynn Dupree confirmed with Megan Matthews, the coordinator of BEINDP 101, that a text written by the instructors of that class includes the PRME and a shortened version of the assignment. This book will be used by all instructors of this class at least exposing them to the topics. • Potential to incorporate into a sexual harassment assignment for BEINDP 101 the Gender Equality SDG along with the Women's Empowerment Goals. 	
Deliverables, Completed Actions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lynn, along with Amy, created and Lynn piloted the assignment in Spring 2017. Lynn uploaded it to the BEINDP 101 website. Unfortunately, no instructors adopted it in the fall due to more required content. • The CoBE PRME Committee rejected the student group materials and outreach plan. However, Dr. Donna Vosburgh worked with a Safety student group on a PRME-related project. There are plans for other outreach as well.
