- 1. <u>Essential Learning Outcomes (ELOs)</u>: implementing or using the ELOs to improve teaching, learning, or student success
- 2. Assessment of student learning: assignments, data, tools, best practices
- 3. <u>High-Impact Educational Practices (HIPs)</u>: implementing, expanding access to, assessing the impact of HIPs
- 4. Inclusive Excellence: access, equity, success for all students
- 5. <u>Signature work</u>: the LEAP Challenge, including capstones, internships, community service, undergraduate research, experiential learning
- 6. <u>Student involvement and engagement with LEAP</u>: how do you involve students in your campus LEAP work?
- 7. Other LEAP-related projects: any LEAP work that doesn't neatly fit a theme listed above

When you submit a proposal, you will be asked to enter the following information:

Author information (name, institution, title, department, and email address for each author)

Theme (choose one, from above)

Title (maximum of 20 words)

<u>Abstract</u> (maximum of 150 words; concise description of the poster suitable for printing directly in the event program)

Proposals will be reviewed for:

- the clarity and quality of the abstract and description,
- effective communication and connection with LEAP (Liberal Education & America's Promise, from AAC&U)

The intention of the poster session is to maximize representation of UW-W departments and units, UW System campuses and the variety of projects implementing LEAP.
