You'll gain useful information to strengthen the course and students appreciate your interest in their perspectives.

- Useful for face-to-face, hybrid, and online courses.
- Feedback summarized and discussed with the instructor by experienced instructors—in time to make changes for the <u>current</u> semester. No need to wait until the next time you teach the course!
- <u>Voluntary and confidential</u>. Requests may only be generated by the instructor, and feedback is given only to the instructor.
- Deadline to apply is October 21, 2016.
