Fit Families Rock Wins WHA Honors Childhood Obesity Intervention Program Honored With Global Vision Award St. Mary's Janesville Hospital Proud to Continue Wellness Program

JANESVILLE, WI – Fit Families Rock is being honored with WHA's 2015 Global Vision Community Partnership Award. "This innovative and comprehensive, community partnership program to combat childhood obesity was selected for the honor because it successfully addresses a documented community health need, and produces measurable outcomes," says WHA Executive Director Jennifer Frank.

One in four children in Rock County are obese or overweight. The county ranks 67th out of Wisconsin's 72 counties in poor health behaviors. Working intensely with a small group of children and parents from ten to 12 families at a time, Fit Families Rock helps to reverse this trend through a comprehensive approach to diet, exercise and education about appropriate screen time and stress reduction behaviors.

"Over the course of this intensive, 11-week program, children and parents learn healthy eating habits and get fit together," says Fit Families Rock Creator Angela Sullivan, community education specialist for St. Mary's Janesville Hospital. "They access the latest research on weight loss and meet with a variety of experts who coach them on facing any challenges associated with adopting a healthier lifestyle."

Since its inception in 2013, Fit Families Rock has yielded several measureable outcomes, according to Sullivan. "Both children and adult participants reported a decrease in screen time and fast food consumption, and an increase in fruit and vegetable consumption," Sullivan says. "The adults also decreased their body mass index, and posted an average weight loss of approximately four pounds."

The program's success is a direct result of the community partnerships behind it, Sullivan says. In addition to St. Mary's Janesville Hospital, Fit Families Rock is supported by Dean Clinic, UW Extension, YMCA of Northern Rock County and the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater.

"It has been a wonderful collaboration, and rewarding to be able to make a difference in people's lives," Sullivan says, "Not only to see the weight loss, but how parents and kids come together to have fun and become more active as a family."
