2009 SUMMER -- FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION SHEET

Important Dates

- February 2, 2009** Summer Priority Registration Begins
- June 30, 2009** The 2008-2009 FAFSA must be received by the federal processor by June 30, 2009.
- July 20, 2009** Application completion **deadline**. Your 2009 Summer Application and all other forms required to complete your file must be received by our office.

**Financial aid cannot be disbursed prior to the dates listed below.

In order to receive financial aid for the summer term, all students must be enrolled on at least a half-time basis (6 credits undergrad, 4.5 credits grad). All summer financial aid information will be mailed to your mailing address. It is your responsibility to keep your address up to date. Verification of current address **must** be done in WINS.

Aid will not credit until you are officially registered for the number of credits for which you were packaged. Refunds are generated after your account has been paid in full.

The "earliest" date of disbursement is only a guide. All other criteria must be met before you will receive your funds.

ELIGIBILITY

- Your financial aid eligibility for the 2009 summer term will be determined by using information provided on the 2008-09 academic year Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). If you have already completed this form and have had the information forwarded to UW-Whitewater, you do **not** need to re-file. Remember, the FAFSA deadline date is June 30, 2009.
- You must meet the Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements as established by the University.
- Students who are academically dismissed and attend summer session as a “qualifier” or new students admitted on probation (conditional admit) are not eligible for summer aid.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

- Submit a completed 2009 Summer Application to the UW-W Financial Aid Office. **Deadline** for submitting the form is July 20, 2009.
- Complete a **2008-09 Free Application for Federal Student Aid** (FAFSA) and **submit** the application to the federal processor. Please note this form must be submitted to and received by the processor by June 30, 2009. The processed information **must** be transmitted to UW-Whitewater by July 13, 2009.
- Verify that all forms have been received prior to the deadline. Your **2009 Summer Application** and all other forms required to complete your file must be in our office by July 20, 2009.
- You must be officially registered for the number of credits for which you were packaged.

FUNDS AVAILABLE

Federal Work-Study

- If you are awarded work-study for summer, your employer must “hire” you, even if you are continuing in the same job. Unearned work-study from spring 2009 is not transferable to summer.
- For assistance in finding a summer work-study job, please call the Financial Aid Office (472-1130).
- The summer payroll period begins May 17, 2009 and goes through August 22, 2009.

William D. Ford Federal Direct Loans (Subsidized or Unsubsidized)

- Federal regulations limit a student's borrowing potential to specific time periods as determined by the school. UW-Whitewater's scheduled fiscal year for loan eligibility is fall/spring with summer as the "trailing" term.

William D. Ford Federal Direct PLUS (Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students) Loan

- Any parent can borrow up to the allowable budget or cost of attendance in PLUS funds. Parents denied the loan due to poor credit may request the student borrow additional “Unsubsidized” Direct Loan funds. PLUS Loan Request Forms are available on the Financial Aid web site.

Alternative Loans

- Alternative loans are private loans borrowed from a lending institution and are not part of a federal financial aid program. These loans should only be used when all other options have been exhausted as they are more expensive than federal government guaranteed loans. Information on these loans can be found on the Financial Aid web site.

Federal Pell Grants, Academic Competitive Grants (ACG) and/or SMART Grants

- Summer Pell, ACG or SMART Grants are awarded to those students who have not used their total eligibility during the 2008-09 academic year.
