***APPLICATION FORM***

International student scholarships have a value of \$5,000 per year. These scholarships may be renewed annually, but the award is limited to a maximum of four years. The scholarships are limited in number and are awarded based on the applicant's previous academic record. The following conditions apply to the administration of these scholarships:

1. Scholarships are restricted to new students and are awarded prior to enrollment. Currently enrolled students are *not* eligible.
2. Recipients must be full-time students (minimum of 12 credits per semester).
3. Recipients must maintain a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (4.0 scale) at the end of each year.
4. A sum of \$2,500 will be applied toward each semester's fees.
5. The number of scholarships available may vary each year and will be awarded on a "rolling" basis (as long as funds remain available).
6. The maximum time period allowed for recipients is eight semesters; however, scholarship will be pro-rated for transfer students.
