Dear Parent/Guardian,

Thank you for your interest in the Pre-College Summer Academic Camps at the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater. Enclosed you will find information regarding our 2009 Summer Camps, including eligibility guidelines, the application process, as well as the goals, objectives, and activities associated with each camp. The camps are open to free and/or reduced lunch students who will be enrolled in the 6-12th grades during the 2008-2009 academic year. All 12th grade applicants must have at least a 2.000 cumulative grade point average. **Due to changes within the state DPI Scholarship Program, participants may only attend one camp per session.** Sessions are January-June, July-September, and October-December. This includes any other programs/campuses affiliated with the DPI Program. As long as the camp program ends in July they can be considered a different session.

The following must be received in order for your application to be complete and admission considered:

1. DPI Form with signatures from school representatives and parent/guardian
2. Copy of most recent report card from the 2008-2009 academic year
3. Medical Form completed and signed by parent/guardian
4. A Household Income Form signed by parent/guardian
5. A completed Program Registration Form

If any of the above is not properly completed or included, it will delay the process of your application, and may cause your son/daughter to be excluded from camp participation. Please indicate the summer program(s) you are applying for on the DPI scholarship form.

PLEASE RETURN THE ABOVE IN THE ENCLOSED SELF-ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE **NO LATER THAN MAY 22, 2009.** Admission priority is determined on a "first-come/first-served" basis until each camp is filled.
