

Verification of Full-Time Status for Enrollment and Financial Aid Purposes

For the purposes of *fee calculation* and *enrollment* verification, UW-Whitewater considers a graduate student to be registered on a full-time basis when the student is enrolled in at least nine (9) UW-Whitewater units during a fall or spring term and at least five (5) UW-W units during the summer term. An undergraduate student is considered full-time when he/she is enrolled in at least twelve (12) UW-W units during a fall or spring term and at least six (6) UW-W units during the summer term.

For purposes of *financial aid*, in accordance with federal regulations, a graduate student must be enrolled in a minimum of nine (9) units in any term (i.e., fall, spring, summer) to be considered full-time and a minimum of four-and-a-half (4.5 units) in any term to be considered half-time. An undergraduate student must be enrolled in at least twelve (12) units in any term (i.e., fall, spring, summer) to be considered full-time and a minimum of six (6) units in any term to be considered half-time.
