



Program Policies

Schools with an economically disadvantaged student population may apply for complimentary seats, subject to availability. **A school is eligible to participate in this program if 35% or more of the student body participates in the federal free and reduced lunch program.** This information must be requested from and confirmed by your district office or school's principal, and supporting documentation in the form of a statement from the district office or letter from the school's principal must accompany your application. The total number of seats requested may not exceed the total number of students who participate in the free and reduced lunch program at your school during the school year.

Apply as early as possible; schools that make requests early in the school year will have the best chance of receiving complimentary seats. **Application to this program does not guarantee that your school will receive complimentary seating for a Horizons performance.** Complimentary seating is at the discretion of the Young Auditorium and *may* become available for a limited number of Horizons performances. School applications will be kept on file until the end of the season and each eligible school that matches the suggested age range for the available performances will be contacted based on the date that their application was received. It will remain the school's responsibility to provide students' transportation to and from Young Auditorium.

To Apply:

1. Complete the Arts4All application form.
2. Obtain supporting documentation verifying FRL percentage from your school district office or principal.
3. Fax or mail the application and supporting documentation to Young Auditorium.

What to Expect:

- You will receive e-mail notification that your application has been reviewed and accepted.
- Your school will be added to the Arts4All participants list.
- You will be notified at least 4 weeks in advance of a Horizons production for which we are able to offer you complimentary seats.
- After accepting complimentary seats for a Horizons performance, you will be sent a letter confirming the number of free seats we are providing and the show date and time.
- Your school will be expected to provide transportation to and from our venue.
