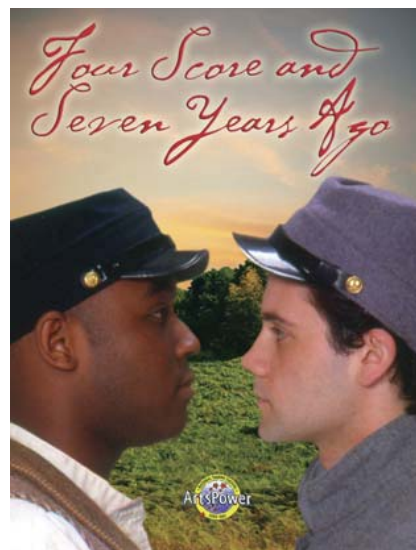
## Horizons Matinee Series 2009 Spring Update
