Get Some SATISFACTION at Young Auditorium

On Saturday, October 3, 2009 at 7:30 p.m. the Young Auditorium will rock the house with *Satisfaction: A Rolling Stones Experience*, a tribute band to the greatest rock-n-roll band of all time the Rolling Stones. Satisfaction- A Rolling Stones Experience is a tribute show honoring the greatest rock-n-roll band, the Rolling Stones. More than just the music, the show captures the magic of a live concert. *Satisfaction* performs all the Stone`s greatest hits including: *I Can`t Get No- Satisfaction*, *Brown Sugar*, *Waiting on a Friend*, *Gimmie Shelter*, and more. It`s only rock-n-roll...but we like it...like it...yes we do!

This glamorous show has been in production and touring since 2001 with over 1200 performance dates to its credit. It is the only full time touring show of its kind in the world. This highly acclaimed production showcases the most authentic cast and costuming audiences have ever witnessed. The likenesses of Mick Jagger, Keith Richards and supporting cast bring a colorful performance to over 45 years of classic hits. *Satisfaction* is featured in dozens of national newspapers, magazines and television ads as the greatest show ever honoring the Rolling Stones and their legacy. The group`s highest accolades arrived in the spring of 2008 when they were honored to be contacted by Paramount Pictures and the IMAX Corporation to assist in promotion of the new Martin Scorsese produced documentary film "Shine a Light". The film highlights the Rolling Stones performance in New York City along with vintage clips from the past. *Satisfaction* will be involved in promotions and special appearances for the film.

Chris LeGrand as Mick Jagger is lead vocalist and is the executive producer for *Satisfaction/The International Rolling Stones Show*. Chris founded the show in 2001 with the goal of producing the first touring tribute show in honor of the World's Greatest Rock & Roll Band. With over 30 years experience in the music industry and a bachelor`s degree in business, Chris has developed the *Satisfaction* show into a 150 date annual touring entity. Other cast members are; Jim Riddick as Keith Richards on guitar and vocals, Charles Trador as Ron Wood on guitar, Tony Fortuna as Bill Wyman on bass and vocals, and Carl Bass as Charlie Watts on percussion.
