Levels of Thinking (LoT)

Application (use methods, concepts, principles and theories in new situations/ requires knowledge, comprehension and interpretation)

Key words: apply, employ, use, interpret, illustrate, demonstrate, operate

Analysis (break down information, processes, or situation into its elements/ requires knowledge, comprehension, interpretation, and application)

Key words: distinguish, calculate, critique, debate, solve, analyze, appraise, differentiate, diagram, relate, examine, justify

Synthesis (put together elements in new, original or creative ways/ requires knowledge, comprehension, interpretation, application and analysis)

Key words: compose, formulate, assemble, construct, set up, manage, design, create, prepare

Evaluation (Judging the value of ideas, materials, and methods by developing and applying criteria and standards/ requires knowledge, comprehension, interpretation, application, analysis and synthesis)

Key words: clarify, evaluate, score, choose, estimate, predict, appraise, rate, select, value, assess
