- a. Nanophysics position search status update: the ranking sheet will be e-mailed for review and initial review of candidates will begin.

A potential new course was discussed: A 3 cr lecture based course called "How Things Work" would appeal to a wide range of students and provide ample sources of discussion of physics in everyday items or items currently in the news (for example, what is the physics behind the Mars Curiosity Rover or 3D televisions.) This could be alternated with the Energy course in the large lecture hall to increase the SCH/FTE.

VI. Announcements

i. Dr. Peter Timbie, UW-Madison presented "How Old is the Universe, and How Do We Know It?", the last of the Fall series of five Whitewater Observatory lectures on "The Age of Life, the Universe and Everything!" There were 95 attendees, about half of whom were students and the rest being members of the wider community.
