UW-Whitewater Science Outreach Monthly Report, Anna Courtier October/Novemeber, 2014

## **Monthly Goals:**

The primary objectives for the outreach office for October/November 2014 focused on: 1) Hosting Wisconsin Science Festival events on UW-Whitewater campus 2) continued activity/event development and planning for elementary, middle school, and high school audiences; 3) networking and developing collaborative and mutually beneficial relationships within UW-W and the surrounding community.

## **Accomplishments:**

- Events and Planning (Goals: Reach elementary, middle, and high school audiences)
  - Wisconsin Science Festival (Target Audience: Kids/Families)
    - Media coverage in local papers the week prior to the event
      - Jefferson County Daily Union and Janesville Gazette
        - Both papers led to inquires from the public
    - Astronomy Lecture by Bob Benjamin: Friday October 17, 8 p.m.
      - Developed flyer for advertising
      - ~70 people in attendance, age 11 Adult
    - Passport to Science event: Saturday, October 18, 9 a.m. noon
      - Distributed 1500 flyers to UW-Whitewater child care center, Whitewater elementary schools (3), and Fort Atkinson elementary schools (4)
        - o Best turn-out from Fort Atkinson
      - Activities focused on ties to UW-W campus and community, including lab tours and activities:
        - Tree rings (log cabin), local leaf ID, rock and mineral ID (campus landscaping), water filtration and stormwater run-off
        - o Observatory and Greenhouse open house
        - Research lab highlights (Curran, Nawash, Sayhun, and Yavuzcetin)
      - Participation included:
        - o 7 UW-W faculty/staff
        - o 3 UW-W student assistants
        - o 15 UW-W undergraduate volunteers
        - o 100 community members attended
        - NASCO donated \$50 gift card to be used for prize drawing (won by a 6 year old from Fort Atkinson)
