Major Planning Guides are sample programs that illustrate the type of curriculum a student will take to complete the degree in 4 years.

All students must complete a minimum of 120 credits including:

- 1) At least 32 units of general education, including specific Gen Ed core courses, as well as approved math and science, physical education, and elective courses. Your general education electives must come from the following categories: GA, GS, GH, GE, or GI.
- 2) All requirements for the BA or BS Degree.
- 3) All requirements for the major and minor (if required).

* ACT/SAT scores determine which Math and English course is appropriate for you. Refer to your AR for this information and then adjust this schedule accordingly. The Planning Guide begins with the most common placement for this major.

** Bachelor of Arts students must demonstrate that they have achieved basic competency in a foreign language equivalent to one year of study at the college level. Students must also complete two 300/400 level courses outside of the major and minor subjects.

Courses in **bold** typeface indicate specific courses that must be completed for the major. Courses in **bold italic** indicate samples chosen from a number of options required for the major (see the Catalog for a full listing of options). Other courses such as GenEd Courses or major/minor electives can be selected from a number of course choices.
