CHUCK AND MARTHA HEINRICH SCHOLARSHIP
Instructions

This scholarship was established by Chuck Heinrich, class of 1969, and Martha Heinrich, a 1974 alumnus of Hanover College. The Heinrichs have been generous donors of their time, leadership, and resources to UW-W and to numerous other charities. Chuck believes he owes much of his success to the breadth of his education in the College of Letters and Sciences at UW-W. Chuck and Martha enjoy traveling, boating, skiing and staying active with alumni events.

The award is \$1,000. For eligibility, students must be a UW-W junior or senior at the time of the award; have declared a major within Letters and Sciences either in Mathematics* or Sociology; and possess and maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0. Please note that preference may be given to out-of-state candidates. The scholarship is renewable, but the candidate must re-submit an application and complete the selection process each year. In the event the recipient voluntarily discontinues his or her UW-W education, or fails to remain in good academic standing, (s)he shall forfeit all rights of the scholarship and the money shall revert back to the fund.

****Note: Mathematics Education is not a major within the College of Letters & Sciences.***

Applications must include the following:

1. A completed application form. (Application forms are available online at www.uww.edu/cls/scholar_awards.);
2. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member in the student's major; and
3. A copy of the student's academic report (AR).
