Beginning each March or April, school districts in need of intern(s) for the next school year will begin completing Intern Request form(s). As the Intern Requests are approved by the Wisconsin Improvement Program (WIP), they will be placed on the WIP website (which is accessible by the Intern Office, but not by students). The Intern Office will send updated information to Intern candidates via their UW-W email address. A list of internship openings will also be posted on the bulletin board outside the Teacher Internship Office WH 2036.

It is your responsibility to notify the Teacher Internship Office where to send your file. Only approved files will be sent. Intern candidates should also note the following:

Early Childhood Education (Dual licensure)

ECE majors must have special education and regular education experience. Approval from the ECE Coordinator is necessary.

Middle Childhood through Early Adolescence Majors (1-8)

MC-EA majors who complete their field study placement at the middle school level can only student teach or intern at the elementary level (and vice versa).

Early Adolescence through Adolescence Majors (6-12)

EA-A majors who complete their field study placement at the middle school level can only student teach or intern at the high school level (and vice versa).

Early Childhood through Adolescence Majors (K-12)

must spend a comparable amount of time in an elementary grade and a secondary grade (see your subject area coordinator if you have questions).
